Personal Bible Study and Preparation for Small Group

Tools: Bible, pens, markers, and notes from November 15 sermon. The sermon is also posted on our website www.harvestbrantford.ca

- Try to set aside 15 minutes per day for prayer and personal Bible study using this guide to prepare for your next small group discussion. Prayer and the word of God are two of our four pillars.
- Begin your Bible study with prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to open the eyes of your understanding (psalm 119:18) and to lead you into all truth (John 16:13). As you answer the questions ask yourself “what is the lesson for life in this passage or teaching?” How can I by believing and obeying this truth have victory in my life?
- Make notes of these in your notebook.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit your Comforter and Teacher will teach you truth that you can apply to your life that day.

REVIEW: on November 15 Pastor Kevin introduced us to the shortest of all the 4 gospels, the book of Mark.

PURPOSE: Mark's purpose was to tell Gentiles in Rome and beyond, that Jesus is the Son of God, that repenting and believing in him brings eternal life. Last week we saw John the Baptist sent to prepare the way for King Jesus.

In our passage today Jesus arrives.
