**Read:** Matthew 25:14 – 36

**A.** What is expected of a diligent servant of Christ?

**B.** Read John 15:1–11. Can a believer expect Christ to produce much fruit in them?

**C.** What is necessary for the believer to bear much fruit?

**D.** Where and how are you responding and working for Christ?

**E.** Are you going to produce little or much fruit? What are your goals to do this?

**3. I'm growing in Christ verse 26 – 34**

- A. Who causes the seed to grow according to first Corinthians 3:6 – 9?
- B. Once the farmer has planted the seed, what does he wait expectantly for?
- C. Of what is the parable of the mustard seed a picture?
- D. Share how God has produced fruit or grown you in the last 6 months?

**MEMORY VERSE: 1 Corinthians 3:6–7** “I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth. So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth.”
