



2. Read: Ephesians 2:8-10, and consider the idea of next level faith.

a. How do we get faith? Who gets credit for your faith? Faith is not the result of works, but what is the result of faith? Who gets the credit for your works? What difference does knowing this make?

b. In what ways can this passage encourage you when you doubt your salvation feeling “Maybe I don’t have enough faith?” In what ways can this passage encourage you when you see an area where you need to obey the Lord but feel, “I don’t have the faith to step out and do it”?

c. Read: Luke 4:34, James 2:17-20. Based on what we know of demons through scripture, what is the difference between demons’ belief and saving faith? If you have saving faith, what is misleading in describing your faith as “I have always believed”

d. Mark 9:14-29 gives us an example of next level faith. In what ways is next level faith and saving faith different (give scriptural support)? In what ways are they the same? In what ways is this helpful in pursuing next level faith in your life?
